



CAMP VINCENT – CAMPER PACKING LIST

Please note: Items marked with an asterisk (*) are considered very important.

CLOTHING

- * Warm Pajamas 1 pair
- * Jacket 1 jacket (in case of damp evenings or bad weather)
- * Sweater 2 sweater (for evenings)
- * Long Pants 3 pairs (for going into the woods, evenings)
- * Long Sleeve Shirt 2 pairs (for going into the woods)
- * Shorts 6 pairs (minimum)
- * Bathing Suit 1 appropriate bathing suit (1 piece bathing suits, please)
- * Socks 8 pairs - not just ankle socks but socks that are long enough for pants to be tucked into
- * Underwear 8 pairs
- * Running shoes 2 pairs (in case one pair gets wet)
- Sandals 1 Pair (optional)
- * Hat 1 hat (available for sale on Sundays)
- * T-shirts 8 T-shirts
- White T-Shirt 1 washed, plain white cotton t-shirt (to be used for tie-dye). These are available for sale on Sunday for \$7 per shirt (S, M, L).

TOILETRIES

- * Towels 1 bath, 1 face cloth, 1 beach towel
- * Soap (In a container or ziplock)
- * Toothbrush (travel size)
- * Toothpaste (travel size)
- * Deodorant Depending on age(no aerosol, please)

SLEEPING ARTICLES

- * Sleeping Bag OR Bedding 1 bed sheet +1 or two blankets or sleeping bag *Please note if the camper is a bed-wetter, please send a heavy rubber sheet (twin) and extra sheets and blankets
- Pillow 1 or 2 pillows. Some kids need more.

OTHER ITEMS

- * Water bottle
- Bottled water (optional – our camp has well-water that tastes much different than city water)
- Insect Repellant
- * Flashlight Not “required”, but probably a good idea!
- Books / Cards / Quiet Activities (for use during rest time)

PLEASE NOTE:

1. While Camp Vincent staff makes every effort to ensure that your child leaves camp with all of their belongings, pick-up days are often very busy and hectic!
 - a. Please ensure your child has their name on all of their belongings – this helps to minimize lost or misplaced items.
 - b. Consider making your own list of everything your child brings to camp, and read over the list with your child on pick-up day. This can help alert staff sooner if any items are missing or misplaced.
 - c. Ultimately, Camp Vincent is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.

2. Forbidden Items
 - a. Weapons of any kind (knives, etc)
 - b. Inappropriate materials
 - c. Cellphones / electronics / expensive equipment

*** These items will take away from and will likely hinder the camp experience for your child and other campers.**

Additionally, Camp Vincent is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

3. Additional items your child may want to bring to camp
 - a. Items on the packing list (above)
 - b. Snacks (optional) – we are a **nut free camp**
 - c. Musical instruments (optional, keeping in mind that your child is responsible)
 - d. Pre-stamped envelopes for writing home (optional)
 - e. Smiles, energy and FUN – you're going to have a blast!

4. We occasionally receive requests for campers to bring their own equipment for certain activities. Please note that Camp Vincent WILL supply all necessary equipment to participate in all activities. However, if your child would still like to bring something of their own (fishing rod, bow, canoe paddle / lifejacket, etc), please contact us in advance to make arrangements.
